Family-based care is a way of providing family life for someone else's child in your own home when they are unable to live with their birth family. Unlike adoption, the child remains the legal responsibility of the Department of Children, Seniors and Social Development and/or their birth parents.

We provide a nurturing, loving and safe family-oriented space for a child in need of care. We strive to achieve family based care by bridging the gaps and providing additional supports to carers who are part of our program.

WHY DO CHILDREN COME INTO CARE?

Most children in care have experienced some degree of neglect, and/or physical, emotional or sexual abuse. They all have experienced loss and separation from their birth family.

In Newfoundland and Labrador there is an urgent need for family-based carers.

- Carer support group meetings
- In-home and respite shifts
- Organized activities for carers and the whole family
- Daily mentorship program



ACCESS TO

- Individual and Consultative access to in-home Clinicians
- SNAP® (Stop Now and Plan). Program offering techniques re: children's emotional regulation
- The Autism Services Team, offering ABA therapy (Applied Behavioral Analysis), assessments, and supportive services
- Youth on Track Music program
- The Key Assets Learning Centre, which provides social-emotional and experimental learning opportunities
- Various training sessions including First Aid, ASIST, and Understanding & Managing Aggressive Behavior
